- If you have not filed your FAFSA, there is still time to qualify for federal financial aid! Go to fafsa.gov and fill out your FAFSA now!
- **Final Transcripts submission to colleges:** Once you have decided on a college, please email Melanie Partida at mpartida@mjustd.com. Be sure to provide her the full address you would like it mailed to or provide her with the link to submit it online. Also make sure to tell her what the deadline is to submit the transcript for you.
- **College Scholarship Opportunities:** Be sure to check on the website for each college you applied to for scholarships. Each college, university, trade and vocational school will have their own scholarship application for you to fill out.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Marysville Unified Teachers Association Scholarship:** The Marysville Teachers Association awards 3 scholarships of \$1,000 and 3 MUTA scholarships of \$500 to seniors graduating from a school in the Marysville Joint Unified School District. They also award 2 scholarships for MUTA dependents of \$500 each.

Deadline: April 1, 2021
- **Marysville Rotary High School Scholarship:** Six \$1000 scholarships for graduating seniors planning to attend a two year or four year college or vocational technical school. Must have a 3.0 or above and evidence of service above self in either community or school clubs or organizations. Need is not a criterion. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.*
Deadline: April 1, 2021
- **John J. & Freda C. Monnot Scholarship Fund:** Award amounts range from \$100

to \$5,000. Open to high school senior with a minimum 3.00 GPA planning to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school. Awards are not based solely on financial need. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List* **Deadline: April 1, 2020**

- **Sierra Central Scholarship Program:** This scholarship is available to students who meet the following requirements: graduating high school senior and must be a current member in good standing or have a parent/guardian that is a member in good standing. Application available online at: <https://www.sierracentral.com/services/scholarship-program/> **Deadline: April 1, 2021**
- **Yuba Sutter Bar Association Scholarship:** Based upon scholarship and need. Although there will be a preference in granting the award to students who propose to study law, political science, or government, all students are encouraged to apply. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: April 2, 2021**
- **John and Karin Jelavich Scholarship/Sutter Yuba Community Foundation:** This is a one-time, up to \$1,000 award to be granted to a graduating high school senior to attend an accredited college or university. This scholarship is to be awarded from an endowment grant donated by John I. and Karin Jelavich. **Eligibility:** To be eligible for the scholarship, student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) maintain a 2.5 GPA overall, and 3) show proof of acceptance into a 2- or 4- year college or university. - **Sarah Jackson Memorial Scholarship/Sutter Yuba Community Foundation:** Sarah E. Jackson taught English and Business courses at Yuba City High School from September 1978 until her retirement in June 1992. Her love of teaching was a driving force in her life, second only to her love of family. Those students who were privileged to learn under Sarah's direction readily acknowledge the positive impact she had on their lives. **Eligibility:** Student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) plan to major in Education, English, or Liberal Studies at college, 3) maintain a 2.3 GPA overall, and 4) show proof of acceptance into a 2- or 4- year college or university. - **Workforce Development Scholarship/Sutter Yuba Community Foundation:** This is a one-time \$500 award granted to a graduating high school senior seeking vocational training in an accredited technical or trade school program. Two and four year schools are not excluded. **Eligibility:** To be eligible for the scholarship, student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) maintain a 2.3 GPA overall, and 3) show proof of acceptance to an accredited technical or trade school program. (Majors that require a BS/BA are not eligible) Applications available online at:

- **Cal Water Scholarship Program:** Cal Water has established a scholarship program to assist students residing within its service areas who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs. If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award ranging from \$2,500 to \$10,000. Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements. Applicants must be a high school senior; plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year; not be the child of a current or former employee of California Water Service (Cal Water), California Water Service Group, any of its subsidiaries, or a Member of its Board of Directors. - **The Michael Matteoli Future Farmer Scholarship:** The Michael Matteoli Future Farmer Scholarship Fund was created in memory of Michael Matteoli a farmer and skilled mechanic who lost his life due to a tragic farm related accident in 2018. Michael's passion was working on his family farm. This \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to any graduating senior with an intended career path in the agriculture field or mechanical field. To be eligible, students must have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA, intend to enroll in a 4-year university, 2-year college, or a trade/vocational school. **Deadline: April 9, 2021**
- **Splawn Scholarship:** \$1,000 scholarship based on financial need, 2.6 or above GPA, employment or community service. Students who have extraordinary circumstances in their lives as well as students who may not have the chance to attend college without financial assistance. They are looking for students that understand and exemplify the meaning of "hard work". Apply online at: www.fsrequests.com/splawnscholarship **Deadline: April 11, 2021**
- **CAA Youth Scholarship:** The program awards scholarships to deserving sons or daughters of law enforcement officers, firefighters, and first responders who will attend a four-year college or university. To be eligible, the student must have a father, mother, or natural guardian who meets the following qualifications: the student's school must be located in CA where the parent is a full-time active employee OR within a 100-mile radius of where the parent is a full-time active employee; parent must be a full-time paid member of a law enforcement or fire department. Parent may also be a volunteer member of a fire department; parent must be an active duty law enforcement officer, firefighter, paramedic, or EMT (public sector). Children of administrative staff do not qualify; and children of reserve, part-time, or retired officers or deceased employees do not qualify. - **Yuba-Sutter Cowbelles Scholarship:** This scholarship is available to students from the Yuba-Sutter county area that plan to attend a junior college or university. First consideration will be given to students majoring in the field of beef production, beef husbandry or a related agricultural field. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: April 15, 2021**
- **Arnoldo Avalos Foundation Scholarship:** This scholarship has been established to assist and encourage students in the advancement of higher education at the University of California. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates high academic achievement, dedication to community service, and shows financial need. Must be planning on attending a UC or Ivy League school. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: April 15, 2021**
- **Agents of Change Scholarship:** The Agents of Change (AOC) is proud to announce this scholarship opportunity for seniors that will be attending any community, four-year, or vocational college. Requires a 2.5 or above GPA and completed application. *Watch in Naviance for application.* **Deadline: April 23, 2021**
- **Foothill Lions Club Scholarship:** This scholarship is for Marysville High School students who reside in the Foothill community only. - **Abbott & Fenner Scholarship:** This scholarship is open to graduating seniors who are planning to enroll in either a 2 or 4-year college/university. To apply, students will need to write an essay on a specific topic. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: June 12, 2021**
- **Big Sun Scholarship:** All student athletes are eligible regardless of the sport they are engaged in. The student must be a high school senior or be attending a post-secondary institution. Apply online at: <http://bigsunathletics.com> **Deadline: June 19, 2021**
