General Information

1. **Do you want to take classes at Yuba College next semester?** The Spring 2021 application is now open online at the Yuba College website www.yc.yccd.edu. High School Dual/Concurrent Enrollment students will be able to submit the completed pink High School Counselor Recommendation Form starting Monday, December 9th. Ask your counselor to fill out a form for you and bring it to Yuba College to apply.
2. **FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid** is the form to apply for financial aid for college. All families should complete this application no matter what their income by the **March 2, 2021 deadline**. This will be used to evaluate Cal Grants, Federal Aid such as Pell Grants, school aid, and some scholarships. It is also required to determine eligibility for the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver). This permits enrollment fees to be waived. Yuba College requires completion of the FAFSA to qualify for the Yuba College Promise which will pay for tuition for new, first-time Yuba College students for up to two years. SCHOLARSHIPS

1. **Equitable Excellence Scholarship:** Provides financial assistance to students displaying the following characteristics: ambition and drive, determination to set and reach goals, respect for self, family and community, and the ability to succeed in college. One recipient from each state will be awarded \$10,000. 10 recipients will be chosen for national recognition with the award value of \$25,000. 2. **Navy ROTC:** National Scholarship selectees (Navy, Nurse and Marine Options) must attend and complete New Student Indoctrination during the summer prior to reporting to their assigned Unit. The NROTC scholarship is merit based and once activated, minimum levels of academic, aptitude, and physical fitness performance are required to maintain the scholarship. <https://www.nrotc.navy.mil/index.html> **Deadline: December 31, 2020**

3. **GE- Reagan Foundation Scholarship:** This \$10,000 renewable scholarship is for students who demonstrate exceptional leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship. 4. **Ron Brown Scholar Program:** The Ron Brown Scholar Program provides Scholars with financial resources to attend some of the finest colleges and universities in the country. Upon acceptance, Scholars are each awarded \$40,000(\$10,000 per year for 4 years) that may be used for college or university of their choice. To be eligible, applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents and a Black/African American. Acceptance into the program means Scholars are also provided with the nurturing and mentorship to succeed and flourish in college and beyond. 5. **America's Farmers Grow AG Leaders:** This \$1500 is for students who plan to pursue a degree in an agriculture related field of study. Must meet a minimum 2.5 GPA. <https://www.americasfarmers.com/grow-ag-leaders/> **Deadline: January 14, 2021**
6. **Elks Legacy Award:** This \$4000 scholarship for children or grandchildren of Elks members. Applications available at <https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/Legacy.cfm> **Deadline: January 31, 2021**
7. **eQuality Scholarship Collaborative:** This scholarship is available to Northern and central California to recognize service to the lesbian/gay/bisexual/transgender community. Apply online at <https://www.equalityscholarship.org/apply.html> **Deadline: January 31, 2021**
8. **California Farm Bureau Federation:** Approximately 30 awards ranging from \$1,500 to \$2750. Open to any senior planning to attend a four-year accredited college or university in California and pursuing a career in the agricultural industry. 9. **Distinguished Raven FAC Memorial Scholarship:** This scholarship is an award presented annually to a qualifying descendant of a Lao or Hmong individual who served in the Royal Laotian Military or Hmong forces in defense of the Kingdom of Laos between 1960- 1975. 10. **College Board Opportunity Scholarship:** The College Board Opportunity Scholarships program is currently open to the class of 2021 students in the United States, Puerto Rico, and US territories, regardless of citizenship status. US citizens and residents attending Department of Defense Education Activity schools abroad may also participate. Students in the class of 2022 will be eligible

- 11. Redbud Garden Club Scholarship:** This scholarship is open to students who plan to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year program of Environmental Horticulture, Agricultural Science, Conservation, Floriculture, Forestry, or a related field. The students must be accepted at an accredited educational institution, have at least a 3.0 GPA, and be a resident of either Yuba or Butte County. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 1, 2021**
- 12. California Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver and the Yuba College Promise):** Community Colleges are implementing a program which allows for First Time Freshmen in college who are enrolled Full Time (12 or more units) to receive a waiver of their tuition for the first two years. This is not income based, but students must submit a FAFSA in order to qualify. <https://studentaid.ed.gov> **FAFSA deadline is: March 2, 2021**
- 13. Cabrillo Civic Clubs of California Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship for a student of Portuguese descent with at least a 3.5 GPA and participation in 3 extracurricular activities. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 15, 2021**
- 14. Marysville High School Local Scholarship:** This application is used for a number of different local scholarships. These scholarships are merit based as well as need based, so all students are encouraged to apply. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 15. Barton Preston Scholarship for Mathematics:** Award amount \$500. This scholarship is open to seniors that have attended Marysville High School for at least three years, have completed Pre-Calculus, and must be planning to attend college immediately after graduation. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 16. Gregory D. Wright Memorial Scholarship:** This award amount is set at \$200. This scholarship was established by the Wright family in loving memory of their son and brother Gregory D. Wright. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 17. Marysville Unified Teachers Association Scholarship:** The Marysville Teachers Association awards 3 scholarships of \$1,000 and 3 MUTA scholarships of \$500 to seniors graduating from a school in the Marysville Joint Unified School District. They also award 2 scholarships for MUTA dependents of \$500 each. Apply online at <http://www.marysvilleteachers.org/scholarship-application.html> **Deadline: April 1, 2021**
- 18. Arnoldo Avalos Foundation Scholarship:** This scholarship has been established to assist and encourage students in the advancement of higher education at the University of California. The scholarship will be awarded to a

student who demonstrates high academic achievement, dedication to community service, and shows financial need. Must be planning on attending a UC or Ivy League school. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: April 15, 2021**

19. Abbott & Fenner Scholarship: This scholarship is open to graduating seniors who are planning to enroll in either a 2 or 4-year college/university. To apply, students will need to write an essay on a specific topic. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: June 12, 2021**

20. California CHAFEE Grant Program: Grants available to current or former foster youth. The court must have established your dependency when you are between the ages of 16 and 18. The California Department of Social Services will verify your foster youth eligibility status. Apply online at <https://www.chafee.csac.ca.gov/> **Deadline: Ongoing**
