

MARYSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL COLLEGE INFORMATION AND SCHOLARSHIP BULLETIN February 2021

General Information

1. **FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid** is the form to apply for financial aid for college. All families should complete this application no matter what their income by the **March 2, 2021 deadline**. This will be used to evaluate Cal Grants, Federal Aid such as Pell Grants, school aid, and some scholarships. It is also required to determine eligibility for the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver). This permits enrollment fees to be waived. Yuba College requires completion of the FAFSA to qualify for the Yuba College Promise which will pay for tuition for new, first-time Yuba College students for up to two years. 2. **What is the Student Aid Report (SAR)?**: The Student Aid Report (SAR) is a paper/electronic document that gives you some basic information about your eligibility for federal student aid and lists your answers to the questions on your FAFSA. If you provided a valid e-mail address on your FAFSA, you will receive an email with instructions on how to access an online copy of your SAR. If you did not **(1)** provide a valid email address on your FAFSA, **(2)** the social security number you included in your FAFSA did not match the one on file for you with the Social Security Administration, or **(3)** you did not sign your FAFSA, you will receive either a SAR or a SAR Acknowledgement via mail. Typically, you will be able to access your SAR within 2 weeks of filing your FAFSA. **Note:** Any student with an FSA ID can view or print their SAR by logging in to their account on the FAFSA homepage, then selecting view/print your SAR from the “My FAFSA” page. SCHOLARSHIPS

1. **Golden 1 Credit Union Scholarship:** Recipients of this scholarship can receive up to \$1,000 annually to full-time students who plan to attend an accredited, nonprofit, two-year community college in California or up to \$5,000 annually to full-time students who plan to attend an accredited, nonprofit, four-year college or university in California. In order to be eligible, students must have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher, be involved in community service totaling at least 24 hours in the last 12 months, and be a Golden 1 member for at least one year, or

be a dependent of someone who has been a member for at least one year.

2. California Farm Bureau Federation: Approximately 30 awards ranging from \$1,500 to \$2750. Open to any senior planning to attend a four-year accredited college or university in California and pursuing a career in the agricultural industry. 3. Wildcat Scholarship and the California State University, Chico President's Scholars Program: Seniors planning to attend CSU, Chico can apply for these scholarship opportunities at: <https://www.csuchico.edu/fa/scholarships/wildcat.shtml> **Deadline: February 22, 2021**

4. The Dream.US National Scholarship: The Dream.US Scholarship is open to all undocumented students who came to the United States before November 1st, 2015. This scholarship awards up to \$33,000 for first-time college students or community college graduates. 5. Distinguished Raven FAC Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship is an award presented annually to a qualifying descendant of a Lao or Hmong individual who served in the Royal Laotian Military or Hmong forces in defense of the Kingdom of Laos between 1960- 1975. 6. College Board Opportunity Scholarship: The College Board Opportunity Scholarships program is currently open to the class of 2021 students in the United States, Puerto Rico, and US territories, regardless of citizenship status. US citizens and residents attending Department of Defense Education Activity schools abroad may also participate. Students in the class of 2022 will be eligible in late 2020. 7. Redbud Garden Club Scholarship: This scholarship is open to students who plan to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year program of Environmental Horticulture, Agricultural Science, Conservation, Floriculture, Forestry, or a related field. The students must be accepted at an accredited educational institution, have at least a 3.0 GPA, and be a resident of either Yuba or Butte County. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 1, 2021**

8. California Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver and the

Yuba College Promise): Community Colleges are implementing a program which allows for First Time Freshmen in college who are enrolled Full Time (12 or more units) to receive a waiver of their tuition for the first two years. This is not income based, but students must submit a FAFSA in order to qualify. <https://studentaid.ed.gov> **FAFSA deadline is: March 2, 2021**

9. Sierra College Scholarships: Award amount \$150 to \$2,500. Sierra College offers numerous scholarships for eligible students. In looking at the scholarships note that some require students to be currently enrolled in classes but a wide range of scholarships are available for incoming students.

10. Cabrillo Civic Clubs of California Scholarship: \$500 scholarship for a student of Portuguese descent with at least a 3.5 GPA and participation in 3 extracurricular activities. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 15, 2021**

11. Italian Catholic Federation Scholarship: Award amount \$400. Open to Roman Catholic graduating seniors of Italian descent who have at least a 3.20 GPA. Applicants must be Roman Catholic but need not be of Italian ancestry to qualify if either Roman Catholic parent or grandparent is a member of the "Italian Catholic Federation". 12. Marysville Rotary High School Scholarship: Six \$1000 scholarships for graduating seniors who plan to attend Yuba College full time (12 or more units). Must have a 3.0 or above and evidence of service above self in either community or school clubs or organizations. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 15, 2021**

13. Butte College Foundation: Scholarships for students planning on attending Butte College. The online application process will open in February and close in early March at www.butte.edu/foundation/scholarships.html **Deadline: TBA**

14. Yuba College Scholarships: Yuba College offers two types of scholarships; Yuba Community College District Foundation and External Scholarships (various deadlines). These scholarships are available to incoming, continuing and transferring students. <https://yc.yccd.edu/student/financialaid/scholarships/> **Deadline: March 20, 2021**

15. Marysville High School Local Scholarship: This application is used for a number of different local scholarships. These scholarships are merit based as well as need based, so all students are encouraged to apply. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**

16. Barton Preston Scholarship for Mathematics: Award amount \$500. This scholarship is open to seniors that have attended Marysville High School for at

- least three years, have completed Pre-Calculus, and must be planning to attend college immediately after graduation. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 17. Gregory D. Wright Memorial Scholarship:** This award amount is set at \$200. This scholarship was established by the Wright family in loving memory of their son and brother Gregory D. Wright. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 18. Gail Buttacavoli-Price Memorial Scholarship:** This scholarship was established in memory of Mrs. Gail Buttacavoli-Price who was a teacher at McKenney Intermediate School. Applicants must have graduated from McKenney Intermediate; award amount is \$500. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 19. Hank Sanchez Memorial Scholarship:** Hank Sanchez was born and raised in the Yuba-Sutter area. He was an avid sportsman who was deeply committed to giving back to this community which he dearly loved. It is in that spirit that we are proud to honor Hank's memory and legacy by offering this scholarship in his name. **Eligibility requirements:** (1) Must be a graduating senior at Marysville High School, (2) must be a United States citizen, (3) must demonstrate financial hardship, (4) must have participated in a sport activity while at Marysville High School, (5) must have maintained a 2.5 overall GPA, and (6) must submit proof of acceptance into an accredited college or technical school. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* ***Please turn in application to Ms. Christine in the Career Center*** **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 20. Asian Pacific Fund Scholarship Program:** Minimum 3.0 GPA and U.S. citizen or permanent resident may apply. This fund administers 10 scholarship programs, each with unique eligibility criteria. Scholarship amounts range from \$1,000 to \$20,000. Apply at: www.asianpacificfund.org/scholarships **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- 21. Operating Engineers Local Union #3 Academic Scholarship:** Children of Local 3 members may apply for the scholarship. The parent of the applicant must be a member for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the application. Students must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA and plan to attend an accredited 2-year college, 4-year university, or trade school. 1st place: \$15,000; 2nd place: \$12,500; 3rd place: \$10,000. - 22. Operating Engineers Local Union #3 Merit Scholarship:** Children of Local 3 members may apply for the scholarship. The parent of the applicant must be a member for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the application. OE3 will award twenty-five (25) \$2,000 scholarships. - 23. Marysville Unified Teachers Association Scholarship:** The Marysville Teachers Association awards 3 scholarships of \$1,000 and 3 MUTA scholarships of \$500 to seniors graduating from a school in the Marysville Joint Unified School District. They also award 2 scholarships for MUTA dependents of \$500 each.

- 24. The Michael Matteoli Future Farmer Scholarship:** The Michael Matteoli Future Farmer Scholarship Fund was created in memory of Michael Matteoli, a farmer and skilled mechanic who lost his life due to a tragic farm related accident in 2018. Michael's passion was working on his family farm. This \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to any graduating senior with an intended career path in the agriculture field or mechanical field. To be eligible, students must have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA, intend to enroll in a 4-year university, 2-year college, or a trade/vocational school. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: April 1, 2021**
- 25. Sierra Central Scholarship Program:** This scholarship is available to students who meet the following requirements: graduating high school senior and must be a current member in good standing or have a parent/guardian that is a member in good standing. - 26. John and Karin Jelavich Scholarship:** This is a one-time, up to \$1,000 award to be granted to a graduating high school senior to attend an accredited college or university. This scholarship is to be awarded from an endowment grant donated by John I. and Karin Jelavich. **Eligibility:** To be eligible for the scholarship, student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) maintain a 2.5 GPA overall, and 3) show proof of acceptance into a 2- or 4- year college or university. - 27. Sarah Jackson Memorial Scholarship:** Sarah E. Jackson taught English and Business courses at Yuba City High School from September 1978 until her retirement in June 1992. Her love of teaching was a driving force in her life, second only to her love of family. Those students who were privileged to learn under Sarah's direction readily acknowledge the positive impact she had on their lives. **Eligibility:** Student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) plan to major in Education, English, or Liberal Studies at college, 3) maintain a 2.3 GPA overall, and 4) show proof of acceptance into a 2- or 4- year college or university. 28.Workforce Development Scholarship: This is a one-time \$500 award granted to a graduating high school senior seeking vocational training in an accredited technical or trade school program. Two and four year schools are not excluded.

Eligibility: To be eligible for the scholarship, student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) maintain a 2.3 GPA overall, and 3) show proof of acceptance to an accredited technical or trade school program. (Majors that require a BS/BA are not eligible) Applications can be downloaded from their website

29.Cal Water Scholarship Program: Cal Water has established a scholarship program to assist students residing within its service areas who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs. If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award ranging from \$2,500 to \$10,000.

Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements. Applicants must be a high school senior; plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year; not be the child of a current or former employee of California Water Service (Cal Water), California Water Service Group, any of its subsidiaries, or a Member of its Board of Directors. 30.Yuba-Sutter Cowbelles Scholarship: This scholarship is available to students from the Yuba-Sutter county area that plan to attend a junior college or university. 34. California CHAFEE Grant Program: Grants available to current or former foster youth. The court must have established your dependency when you are between the ages of 16 and 18.
