MARYSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL COLLEGE AND SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION BULLETIN MARCH 2021

General Information:

- <u>FAFSA Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> is the form to apply for financial aid for college. All families should complete this application no matter what their income by the March 2, 2021 deadline. This will be used to evaluate Cal Grants, Federal Aid such as Pell Grants, school aid, and some scholarships. It is also required to determine eligibility for the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver). This permits enrollment fees to be waived. Yuba College requires completion of the FAFSA to qualify for the Yuba College Promise which will pay for tuition for new, first-time Yuba College students for up to two years. Apply online at <u>https://studentaid.ed.gov</u> IF YOU MISSED THE MARCH 2nd DEADLINE, STILL APPLY. YOU MAY STILL QUALIFY FOR PELL GRANTS AND CALIFORNIA COLLEGE PROMISE GRANT IF FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE.
- 2. To find out how much money you received after completing the FAFSA, please make sure to check these important sites for more information on your financial aid package:
 - a. <u>What is the Student Aid Report (SAR)?</u>: The Student Aid Report (SAR) is a paper/electronic document that gives you some basic information about your eligibility for federal student aid and lists your answers to the questions on your FAFSA. If you provided a valid e-mail address on your FAFSA, you will receive an email with instructions on how to access an online copy of your SAR. If you did not (1) provide a valid email address on your FAFSA, (2) the social security number you included in your FAFSA did not match the one on file for you with the Social Security Administration, or (3) you did not sign your FAFSA, you will receive either a SAR or a SAR Acknowledgement via mail. Typically, you will be able to access your SAR within 2 weeks of filing your FAFSA. *Note:* Any student with an FSA ID can view or print their SAR by logging in to their account on the FAFSA homepage, then selecting view/print your SAR from the "My FAFSA" page.  - b. **Create your CSAC WebGrants-4-Students account at:** <u>https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/</u> The California Student Aid Commission has created this just for you, the student. The goal is to provide you with resources, information and tools you need to assist you with the college financial aid process. This site will also allow you to manage your Cal Grant

and/or Chafee account(s) online by letting you view updates, make school changes, make address changes and post leave of absence requests.

3. **College Scholarship Opportunities:** Be sure to check on the website for each college you applied to for scholarships. Each college, university, trade and vocational school will have their own scholarship application for you to fill out.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Redbud Garden Club Scholarship:** This scholarship is open to students who plan to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year program of Environmental Horticulture, Agricultural Science, Conservation, Floriculture, Forestry, or a related field. The students must be accepted at an accredited educational institution, have at least a 3.0 GPA, and be a resident of either Yuba or Butte County. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 1, 2021**
- California Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver and the Yuba College Promise): Community Colleges are implementing a program which allows for First Time Freshmen in college who are enrolled Full Time (12 or more units) to receive a waiver of their tuition for the first two years. This is not income based, but students must submit a FAFSA in order to qualify. <u>https://studentaid.ed.gov FAFSA deadline is: March 2, 2021</u>
- Sierra College Scholarships: Award amount \$150 to \$2,500. Sierra College offers numerous scholarships for eligible students. In looking at the scholarships note that some require students to be currently enrolled in classes but a wide range of scholarships are available for incoming students. - The Tri Counties Bank Income Based Scholarship: Tri Counties Bank competitively awards \$1,500 scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to attend a 4-year college/university and \$1,000 for those who will attend a community college. The requirements include having a minimum GPA of 2.5 and having an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$5,711 or less - verification required via completion of the FAFSA or CA Dream Act Financial Aid application. • The Tri Counties Bank Merit Based Scholarship: Tri Counties Bank offers a merit based scholarship opportunity for graduating high school students who display outstanding achievements in academics, community service, or business entrepreneurship. Requirements include having a weighted cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Displaying outstanding achievements in academics, community service, and/or business entrepreneurship during high school career and being an undergraduate student the fall semester following high school graduation. - Mary Aaron Memorial Trust: Open to ANY deserving student who is in need of financial assistance in order to complete their college education regardless of grades or participation in school activities. - **Cabrillo Civic Clubs of California Scholarship:** \$500 scholarship for a student of Portuguese descent with at least a 3.5 GPA and participation in 3 extracurricular activities. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline:** <u>March 15, 2021</u>
- Italian Catholic Federation Scholarship: Award amount \$400. Open to Roman Catholic graduating seniors of Italian descent who have at least a 3.20 GPA. Applicants must be Roman Catholic but need not be of Italian ancestry to qualify if either Roman Catholic parent or grandparent is a member of the "Italian Catholic Federation". - Yuba College Scholarships: Yuba College offers two types of scholarships; Yuba Community College District Foundation and External Scholarships (various deadlines). - Yuba Sutter Farm Bureau: Open to high school seniors from Yuba and Sutter counties, the Scholarship Program awards one-time gifts of \$500 or more to a minimum of four students annually. To qualify, the student must be a senior currently enrolled in a public or private high school in either Yuba or Sutter County, must have an average to above average academic record, and plan to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited school. - **Marysville High School Local Scholarship:** This application is used for a number of different local scholarships. - **Barton Preston Scholarship for Mathematics:** Award amount \$500. This scholarship is open to seniors that have attended Marysville High School for at least three years, have completed Pre-Calculus, and must be planning to attend college immediately after graduation. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**

- **Gregory D. Wright Memorial Scholarship:** This award amount is set at \$200. This scholarship was established by the Wright family in loving memory of their son and brother Gregory D. Wright. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List.* **Deadline: March 26, 2021**
- Hank Sanchez Memorial Scholarship: Hank Sanchez was born and raised in the Yuba-Sutter area. He was an avid sportsman who was deeply committed to giving back to this community which he dearly loved. It is in that spirit that we are proud to honor Hank's memory and legacy by offering this scholarship in his name. Eligibility requirements: (1) Must be a graduating senior at Marysville High School, (2) must be a United States citizen, (3) must demonstrate financial hardship, (4) must have participated in a sport activity while at Marysville High School, (5) must have maintained a 2.5 overall GPA, and (6) must submit proof of acceptance into an accredited college or technical school. *The application can be found on Naviance in the Scholarship List*. - Asian Pacific Fund Scholarship Program: Minimum 3.0 GPA and U.S. citizen or permanent resident may apply. This fund administers 10 scholarship programs, each with unique eligibility criteria. - **Operating Engineers Local Union #3 Academic Scholarship:** Children of Local 3 members may apply for the scholarship. The parent of the applicant must be a member for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the application. Students must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA and plan to attend an accredited 2-year college, 4-year university, or trade school. 1st place: \$15,000; 2nd place: \$12,500; 3rd place: \$10,000. - **Operating Engineers Local Union #3 Merit Scholarship:** Children of Local 3 members may apply for the scholarship. The parent of the applicant must be a member for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the application. OE3 will award twenty-five (25) \$2,000 scholarships. - Sierra Central Scholarship Program: This scholarship is available to students who meet the following requirements: graduating high school senior and must be a current member in good standing or have a parent/guardian that is a member in good standing. • Workforce Development Scholarship/Sutter Yuba Community Foundation: This is a one-time \$500 award granted to a graduating high school senior seeking vocational training in an accredited technical or trade school program. Two and four year schools are not excluded. Eligibility: To be eligible for the scholarship, student applicants must 1) be a graduating senior at a high school in the Yuba-Sutter area, 2) maintain a 2.3 GPA overall, and 3) show proof of acceptance to an accredited technical or trade school program. • **Cal Water Scholarship Program:** Cal Water has established a scholarship program to assist students residing within its service areas who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs. To be eligible, the student must have a father, mother, or natural guardian who meets the following qualifications: the student's school must be located in CA where the parent is a full-time active employee OR within a 100-mile radius of where the parent is a full-time active employee; parent must be a full-time paid member of a law enforcement or fire department. Parent may also be a volunteer member of a fire department; parent must be an active duty law enforcement officer, firefighter, paramedic, or EMT (public sector).
