


#### MARYSVILLE HIGH CINDERELLA CLOSET

The Winter Formal is on December 7th and the Prom is on May 16, 2020.





#### **General Information**

- 1. Helpful websites:

- 2. <u>Do you want to take classes at Yuba College next semester?</u> The Spring 2020 application is now open online at the Yuba College website <u>yc.yccd.edu</u>. High School Dual/Concurrent Enrollment students will be able to submit the completed pink High School Counselor Recommendation Form starting Monday, Dec 3rd. Ask your school counselor to fill out a form for you and bring it to Yuba College to apply.
- 3. FAFSA Free Application for Federal Student Aid is the form to apply for financial aid for college. All families should complete this application no matter what their income by the March 2, 2019 deadline. This will be used to evaluate Cal grants, Federal Aid such as Pell Grants, school aid and some scholarships. It is also required to determine eligibility for the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver). This permits enrollment fees to be waived. Yuba College requires completion of the FAFSA to qualify for the Yuba College Promise which will pay for tuition for new, first-time Yuba College students for up to two semesters. #### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

- 1. Ron Brown Scholar Program: The Ron Brown Scholar Program provides Scholars with financial resources to attend some of the finest colleges and universities in the country. Upon acceptance, Scholars are each awarded \$40,000(\$10,000 per year for 4 years) that may be used for college or university of their choice. To be eligible, applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents and a Black/African American. Acceptance into the program means Scholars are also provided with the nurturing and mentorship to succeed and flourish in college and beyond. - 12. California Association of Wine Grape Growers Foundation: This scholarship opportunity is available for children whose parents or legal guardians are employees of a California wine grape grower working in the 2019-2020 wine grape growing season. At least three 4-year scholarships worth \$8000 each and three 2-year scholarships worth \$2000 each will be awarded to qualifying students. Students may study the subject of their choice at any campus within the University of California system, California State system or California Community College system. - **16. Gregory D. Wright Memorial Scholarship:** Award amount \$200. This scholarship was established by the Wright family in loving memory of their son and brother Gregory D. Wright. Pick up from the Scholarship Bin in the Career Center. **Deadline:** March **27, 2020**

- 17. Arnoldo Avalos Foundation Scholarship: This scholarship has been established to assist and encourage students in the advancement of higher education at the University of California. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates high academic achievement, dedication to community service, and show financial need. Must be planning on attending a UC or Ivy League school. Pick up from the Scholarship Bin in the Career Center. Deadline: April 15, 2020


