



### MARYSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL COLLEGE INFORMATION AND SCHOLARSHIP BULLETIN April 2023

#### **General Information**

• If you have not filed your FAFSA, there is still time to qualify for federal financial aid! Go to fafsa.gov and fill out your FAFSA now!

**College Scholarship Opportunities:** Be sure to check on the website for each college you applied to for scholarships. Each college, university, trade and vocational school will have their own scholarship application for you to fill out. Also check goingmerry.com, studentscholarships.org and naviance for scholarships.

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

- 1. Marysville Unified Teachers Association Scholarship: The Marysville Teachers Association awards 3 scholarships of \$1,000 and 3 MUTA scholarships of \$500 to seniors graduating from a school in the Marysville Joint Unified School District. They also award 2 scholarships for MUTA dependents of \$500 each. - 2. Marysville Rotary High School Scholarship: Six \$1000 scholarships for graduating seniors planning to attend a two year or four year college or vocational technical school.. Must have a 3.0 or above and evidence of service above self in either community or school clubs or organizations. Need is not a criterion. Go to your naviance account, click scholarships to download the application. Deadline: April 1, 2023
- **3. Yuba Sutter Bar Association Scholarship:** Based upon scholarship and need. Although there will be a preference in granting the award to students who propose to study law, political science, or government, all students are encouraged to apply. *Please pick up an application in the Scholarship Bin in the Career Center.* **Deadline: April 3, 2023**

- **4. John J. & Freda C. Monnot Scholarship Fund:** Award amounts range from \$100 to \$5,000. Open to high school seniors with a minimum 3.00 GPA planning to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school. Awards are not based solely on financial need. To apply go to your naviance account and download the application. **Deadline: April 4, 2023**
- 5. Don Splawn Scholarship: \$250-\$2000 scholarship based on financial need, 2.6 or above GPA, employment or community service. Students who have extraordinary circumstances in their lives as well as students who may not have the chance to attend college without financial assistance. They are looking for students that understand and exemplify the meaning of "hard work". Apply online at https://online.foundationsource.com/ws/index.jsp?site=splawnscholarship Deadline: April 19, 2023
- 6. The Michael Matteoli Future Farmer Scholarship: The Michael Matteoli Future Farmer Scholarship Fund was created in memory of Michael Matteoli a farmer and skilled mechanic who lost his life due to a tragic farm related accident in 2018. Michael's passion was working on his family farm. This \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to any graduating senior with an intended career path in the agriculture field or mechanical field. To be eligible, students must have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA, intend to enroll in a 4-year university, 2-year college, or a trade/vocational school. *Pick up an application in the Scholarship Bin in the Career Center*. **Deadline: April 14, 2023**
- 7. Marysville High School FFA Senior Scholarship: The Marysville FFA Alumni and Ag Boosters are offering a scholarship to graduating seniors who are FFA members. *Pick up an application in the Scholarship Bin in the Career Center*. **Deadline: April 13, 2022**
- **8. CAA Youth Scholarship:** The program awards scholarships to deserving sons or daughters of law enforcement officers, firefighters, and first responders who will attend a four-year college or university. To be eligible, the student must have a father, mother, or natural guardian who meets the following qualifications: the student's school must be located in CA where the parent is a full-time active employee OR within a 100-mile radius of where the parent is a full-time active employee; parent must be a full-time paid member of a law enforcement or fire department. Parents may also be a volunteer member of a fire department; parents must be an active duty law enforcement

officer, firefighter, paramedic, or EMT (public sector). Children of administrative staff do not qualify; and children of reserve, part-time, or retired officers or deceased employees do not qualify. *Apply online at https://www.caaonline.org/programs/youth-scholarship-program/* **Deadline: April 14, 2023** 

- 9. Alliance For Hispanic Advancement: The Alliance for Hispanic Advancement (AHA) scholarship is for students that will be attending a vocational, trade school, community college or university fall 2023. Scholarship award amount is for a total of \$500 cash award for one academic year. To apply go to your naviance account and download the application Deadline: April 15, 2023
