

Date: Friday, May 19, 2023

Cost: \$50 presale (4/19-4/25) \$60 after from 4/26-5/1 (last day to purchase is 5/1)

Departure Time: 8:00 am from MHS

Return Time: 8:00 pm to MHS parking lot

Who Can Attend: MHS Class of 2023 Graduating Seniors ONLY

Transportation: Provided by the Senior Class

Cost Includes: Ticket, lunch and transportation

Cost does NOT Include: Breakfast, dinner, snacks, or other purchases

Refund: No refunds are available because tickets will be purchased before going on the trip.

Deadline to submit permission slip: Friday 5/12/23

Bus seating: 1st come 1st serve as permission slips are turned in

Dress code: School attire, comfortable clothing and shoes

Bags/Belongings: Bags will be searched prior to boarding the bus. NO open container may be taken on the bus. Great America does not allow outside food.


Food/Drink: Beverages must be in sealed containers. Hydro Flask-like containers must be empty and can be filled with water in the field house prior to departure. Again no outside food or drink allowed in the park.

Medication: School policy for medications will be followed. Students cannot have medication with them without a Doctor's medication form. Students with health care- please see Ms.Wooten.

If a student violates any school policies on the senior day trip, it could jeopardize their graduation status.

ONLY seniors may participate in the MHS Senior Day Trip, and **ONLY** seniors who travel on the bus to Great America on Friday May 19, 2023. Under **NO** circumstances may seniors, or students of any grade level, provide their own transportation as this is a suspendable defiance and disruption offense, CA Ed Code 48900 (k)

General Information

- If you have not filed your FAFSA, there is still time to qualify for federal financial aid! Go to fafsa.gov and fill out your FAFSA now!
- **Final Transcripts submission to colleges:** Once you have decided on a college, pick up an envelope from Melanie Partida in the Main Office and fill it out according to the instructions. Make arrangements with Melanie to have your final official transcript mailed out. Be prepared to turn in the completed envelope and let Melanie know the deadline for submission.

College Scholarship Opportunities: Be sure to check on the website for each college you applied to for scholarships. Each college, university, trade and vocational school will have their own scholarship application for you to fill out. 
