What to Bring

- ❑ Your [FSA ID](#) (FAFSA filers ONLY) or [Dream Act Account](#) (CADAA filers ONLY) -if created
- ❑ Your parent or legal guardian's FSA ID
- ❑ Personal email address for student and parent; if independent student and married spouse email too.
- ❑ Driver's License, if you have one.
- ❑ Social Security Card if you have one.
- ❑ Alien Registration Card if you have one.
- ❑ Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), if you have one.
- ❑ List of colleges you are interested in, include at least one college in California if looking mostly out of state.
- ❑ Most current bank statements.
- ❑ Any records of untaxed income
- ❑ 2022 tax information (1040's and W2's)
 - Dependent student, this includes your parent or legal guardian's tax information.

MARYSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL COLLEGE INFORMATION AND SCHOLARSHIP BULLETIN March 2024

General Information

1. **FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid** is the form to apply for financial aid for college. All families should complete this application no matter what their income by the **June 30, 2024 deadline**. This will be used to evaluate Cal Grants, Federal Aid such as Pell Grants, school aid, and some scholarships. It is also required to determine eligibility for the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver). This permits enrollment fees to be waived. Yuba College requires completion of the FAFSA to qualify for the Yuba College Promise which will pay for tuition for new, first-time Yuba College students for up to two years. Apply online at <https://studentaid.ed.gov>
2. **What is the Student Aid Report (SAR)?**: The Student Aid Report (SAR) is a paper/electronic document that gives you some basic information about your eligibility for federal student aid and lists your answers to the questions on your FAFSA. If you provided a valid e-mail address on your FAFSA, you will receive an email with instructions on how to access an online copy of your SAR. If you did not **(1)** provide a valid email address on your FAFSA, **(2)** the social security number you included in your FAFSA did not match the one on file for you with the Social Security Administration, or **(3)** you did not sign your FAFSA, you will receive either a SAR or a SAR Acknowledgement via mail. Typically, you will be able to access your SAR within 2 weeks of filing your FAFSA. **Note:** Any student with an FSA ID can view or print their SAR by logging in to their account on the FAFSA homepage, then selecting view/print your SAR from the “My FAFSA” page. SCHOLARSHIPS (more scholarships available with March deadlines on naviance, goingmerry.com and studentscholarships.org)

1. **Mary Aaron Memorial Trust:** This is not a scholarship grant, per se. Any deserving student is eligible, regardless of grades or participation in school activities. Funds from the trust are to be awarded only to Yuba and Sutter County residents who will be attending colleges or universities located within the State of California. The trustees are committed to primarily help students that begin their post-secondary education at Yuba College, and then move on to other colleges or universities after completing their general education requirements. *Pick up an application from Stan Easter in the College & Career Center* **Deadline: March 15, 2024**
2. **Yuba Sutter Farm Bureau Scholarship:** Eligibility to apply for a YSFB FAE scholarship is based on the following:
 - A. Student must live in either Yuba or Sutter County;
 - B. Student must be a senior currently enrolled in a public or private high school in Yuba or Sutter County;
 - C. Student should have an average to above-average academic record; and
 - D. In the fall of the next academic year, students plan to enroll in an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school. Apply here <https://www.ysfarmbureau.com/fund-for-ag-education> **Deadline: March 21, 2024**
3. **Marysville High School Local Scholarship:** This application is used for a number of different local scholarships. These scholarships are merit based as well as need based, so all students are encouraged to apply. *Download an application from your senior google classroom or naviance.* **Deadline: March 29, 2024**
4. **Cal Water Scholarship Program:** California Water Service (Cal Water) has established a scholarship program to assist students residing within its service areas who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.
If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award ranging from \$2,500 to \$10,000. Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements. 5. **Italian Catholic Federation Scholarship:** Award amount \$400. Open to Roman Catholic graduating seniors of Italian descent who have at least a 3.20 GPA. Applicants must be Roman Catholic but need not be of Italian ancestry to qualify if either Roman Catholic parent or grandparent is a member of the "Italian Catholic Federation". Application available online at www.icf.org
Deadline: April 1, 2024
6. **Yuba Sutter Bar Association Scholarship:** The Yuba Sutter Bar Association is pleased to announce that it will be granting scholarships to graduating seniors of local high schools in Yuba and Sutter Counties. The awards will be based upon scholarship and need, and will be awarded for the purpose of continuing the student's education. Although there will be a preference in granting the award to students who propose to study law, political science, or government, the award may be made to students studying any other area. Scholarships at the individual school level will be awarded in the amount of \$1,500.00 and one overall scholarship of \$2,500.00 will be selected from all of the applicants.
