High School students can take advantage of Dual Enrollment at Yuba College after completing the 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

Note: According to AP 5020 and AP 5030 high school student's enrollment and health fees are waived.

Exception: High school students in full time status are required to pay both enrollment and health fees.

**STEP 1:** Complete a Yuba College Application online at [yc.yccd.edu](http://yc.yccd.edu)

\*\*Select term planning to enroll, the summer application covers both the summer and fall semester

**STEP 2:** Complete the High School Recommendation Form <https://yc.yccd.edu/admissions/highschool/>

Submit completed and signed form during the Dual Enrollment pre-registration period to get coded for the *first* day of registration for Dual Enrollment students for the term.

Online registration through Yuba College Portal via YC Self Service.

\*\*All forms received after the pre-registration period will be processed as received.

**STEP 3:** Submit completed and signed High School Recommendation Forms to [YCA admissions@yccd.edu](mailto:YCA admissions@yccd.edu) from your Yuba College email or in person to the Admissions Office.

\*\*If attempting to take more than the maximum number of units indicated on the High School Recommendation Form attach unofficial high school transcript with submission.

**English/Math Placement:** High school students can utilize their high school transcript for AB 705 English and Math placement **after** the completion of the 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Submit unofficial high school transcript with High School Recommendation Form for placement.

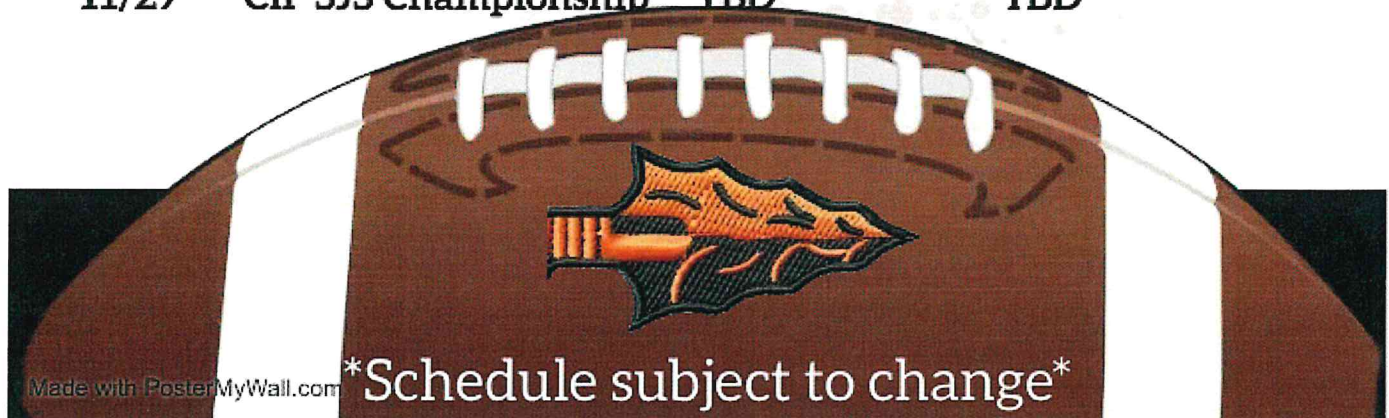

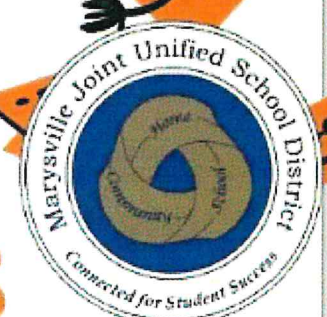
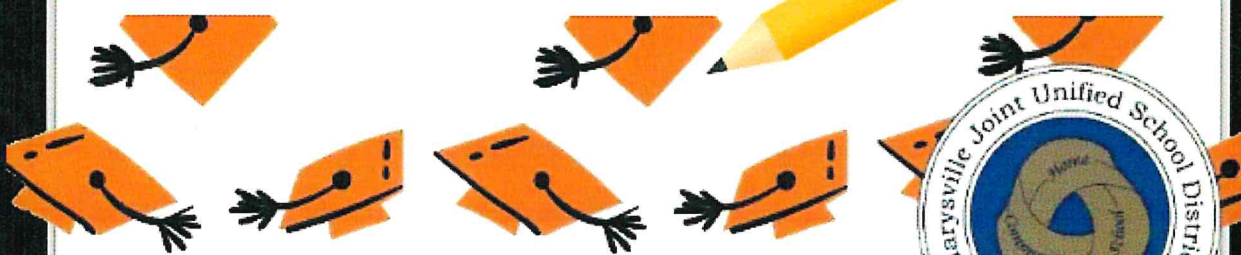
